

The Mishkan Museum of Art, Ein Harod is a magnet for lovers of art and culture, researchers, curators, and artists from Israel and throughout the world. It began as an "art corner" established on the Kibbutz in 1938, in a small wooden shack used as the atelier of local painter Haim Atar, the museum's visionary and founder. Kibbutz members began building the permanent structure of the museum in 1948.

Twelve exhibition halls, sculpture gardens and inner courtyards, a library, restoration studio and an impressive collection of more than 20,000 works of art were built to fulfill the museum's purpose - a place of testament to and exhibition of Jewish and contemporary art, of art education, a place of gathering, and significant expansion of cultural activities within Israel's north and in the field of art in Israel.
